

## MSW/MFT/PCC Training - FACT SHEET

Ventura County Behavioral Health Department (VCBH) is part of the Ventura County's integrated health care system. VCBH provides a system of coordinated outpatient services to meet the mental health and substance use treatment needs of Ventura County. Services are delivered from regionally based behavioral health programs for children and families, adolescents, transitional aged youth (ages 18-25), adults, and seniors. Specialized services are provided in partnership with courts, local law enforcement, schools and community-based organizations.

**MSW, MFT or PCC TRAINING PROGRAM:** VCBH provides comprehensive training in public mental health. Students will gain a wide range of experiences within an integrated, multi-disciplinary behavioral health system and clinical experiences in assessment, intervention and case management.

**TYPES OF TRAINING SITES:** Specialty Mental Health Out-patient services – Youth and Family & Adult programs; juvenile facility, adult residential, specialty

**SITE LOCATIONS:** Oxnard, Ventura, Santa Paula, Fillmore, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, Simi Valley

**SUPERVISION:** Interns/Trainees receive a minimum of 1 hour of individual supervision. Each supervisor meets all the regulations per the Board of Behavioral Sciences. Additional supervision will be provided as needed, and may be in the form of group supervision.

**TRAINING:** Training is an integral component to our program and seminars are provided at various times during the year to augment professional development and enhance clinical experiences.

**TIME COMMITMENT:** The internship/traineeship requires a 9 month commitment, commencing late August or early September, with a minimum of 16 hours per week, scheduled during business hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 8:00am – 6:00pm, Wednesday 8:00am – 6:00pm, Friday 8:00am – 5:00pm.

**TO APPLY:** Complete the Application and submit with a cover letter, curriculum vitae (or resume) and two listed references. A letter of recommendation is optional. This application packet is submitted to the Training and Workforce Development Manager for initial screening. If selected for an interview, your application is shared with appropriate program managers/supervisors **APPLICATION DEADLINE is April 1<sup>st</sup>**, interviews are scheduled in April 2021, with placement notification in May
